S&P to add Tessera Technologies to SmallCap 600

Standard & Poor's said Tuesday that Financial Federal Corp. will be removed from the S&P SmallCap 600 index after trading ends Thursday, Feb. 18. It will be replaced by Tessera Technologies Inc.

Financial Federal is being acquired by the regional bank operator People's United Financial Inc., which is part of the S&P 500. The \$738 million stock and cash deal was first announced in November.

Tessera Technologies will take Financial Federal's place on the SmallCap 600 index. The company, based in San Jose, Calif., licenses miniaturization technology for electronic devices.

Tessera Technologies shares rose 16 cents to close at \$17.14, adding 72 cents, or 4.2 percent, in after-hours trading.
