Chinese Government Honors Tessera CTO

Tessera Technologies Inc. said Monday that its chief technology officer has been named one of the top 60 world Chinese by the government of China.

San Jose-based Tessera (NASDAQ:TSRA) said Robert Yung will also appear on a special edition Chinese postal stamp designed by the People's Republic of China's Postal Ministry.

The Top 60 World Chinese award celebrates China's 60th anniversary, honoring people around the world who have made substantial contributions in their field and advanced China's cultural and economic growth.

Yung was named to the National Committee of U.S.-China Relations Fellows during the inaugural Young Leader Forum in 2002. In 2000, he was also named to the World Economic Forum's "Top 100 Global Leaders for Tomorrow" in Davos, Switzerland.

At Tessera, Yung is responsible for the company's vision for innovation of miniaturization technologies for wireless, consumer and computing electronic devices. He is a named inventor on more than 70 issued patents and more than 20 pending patent applications.
